

TUXEDO TENNIS CLUB INFORMATION AND RULES

1. **TUXEDO TENNIS CLUB (TTC)** is a non-profit organization governed by an annually elected Board of Directors.
2. **TTC** is a member club and pays dues to Tennis Manitoba and, by association, is a member of Tennis Canada.
3. Members of **TTC** must pay annual fees and wear their shoe tag when they are on the courts.
4. **Guests:** Each member/family is given 3 guest passes for family and friends. Other players may drop in and pay a \$10 guest fee for the day. All guests must sign in prior to playing.
5. Proper tennis attire must be worn at all times while on the courts. This means non-marking tennis shoes, shirts on when playing, and no cut-off jeans. Members should change into court shoes on arrival at the clubhouse to protect the court surfaces.
6. **Entrance to club:** If the clubhouse is staffed, players enter through the clubhouse. If the clubhouse is not staffed, players must enter through the side gate using the entry code. Access to clubhouse washrooms is via the door facing the courts using the code provided for the keypad entry.
7. **Court Rotation Board for use during open play:**
 - a) Members must sign up for a court on the board. Singles play is 30 min. Doubles play is 45 minutes.
 - b) Players must take the next available court. There is no court preference.
 - c) Players on the wait list must be on the premises.
 - d) Players cannot have their name on the wait list and be playing at the same time
 - e) Players may not leave the court and rewrite their start time. Players must wait until the posted court time expires before re-signing.
8. There is no smoking allowed on the **TTC** grounds, including within 10 meters of the clubhouse door in the parking lot.
9. When entering or in the court area, be considerate of others:
 - a) Use the appropriate gate to enter, so as not to walk behind other courts.
 - b) Wait until play has stopped before proceeding to your assigned court.
 - c) Do not retrieve your balls from behind another court until play stops or ask the players on the other court to retrieve your ball.
10. On occasion, leagues and tournaments will have precedence over casual play.
11. Members should take pride in helping keep the grounds and clubhouse neat and tidy.
12. All members must be aware of the information and rules. Members are encouraged to remind other members of the rules in a non-threatening way, but ultimate enforcement of the rules is up to the staff and Board of Directors.
