COVID-19 Safe Play Guidelines Tuxedo Tennis Club June, 2021

Members and guests must **not** enter the courts if:

- > You are under public health order to quarantine, self-monitor for symptoms or self-isolate.
- > You are experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever (>38' or subjective fever/chills), cough, sore throat/hoarse voice, shortness of breath/breathing difficulties, loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea for more than 24 hours

 A useful reference is the Province's online screening tool for Covid-19.
- 1. Club access is **only** by the clubhouse door when staff are present.
- 2. A completed on-line screening form (https://forms.gle/VR3okJgT2ezRTThN7) or a signature verifying negative answers to all screening questions is required on every visit before proceeding to play at the club.
- 3. Only 8 people, including staff, are allowed in the clubhouse at one time. Please wait your turn outside if the clubhouse is at capacity. A mask must be worn when inside the clubhouse.
- 4. Courts must be *pre-booked on line at https://holdmycourt.com/reserve2/tuxedotennis
 For instructions on using Hold My Court, go to the Members Only page on the club web site, tuxedotennis.com.
 - *Exceptions for pre-booking are drop-in programs.
- 5. Members and guests must follow staff directions at all times.
- 6. Maintain safe physical distancing of 2 meters at all times. When this is not possible, please wear a mask.
- 7. Please bring your own water and bottle. The water fountain will not be operational.
- 8. Please follow these guidelines when playing:
 - > Wash/sanitize hands before and after play
 - > Enter and exit courts through designated entrance and exit gates.
 - > Hang tennis bags on the fence 2 meters apart from others
 - > No sharing of racquets, other equipment or water bottles.
- 9. Ball machine use allowed but it has to be pre-booked.

Members and guests must follow all protocols and instructions. These will be updated as provincial guidelines change and members will be advised accordingly.
